IMPORTANT Information to note

- The Central Coast Council Acquisition Award for \$2,500 is, in the Judges' opinion, *the best example in any medium on any subject* exhibited. Council will acquire the work for display in the Council Foyer for 12 months. It will be hung later in other Central Coast public buildings as part of the Council's collection.
- Eight categories will be judged professionally on the basis of artistic and presentation merit. Prizes will be awarded to the winners of each category. *The artist retains the work unless it is acquired by a sponsor or sold to someone attending the Exhibition.*
- *Fourteen sponsors* in addition to Central Coast Council have agreed to acquire one or more paintings of their choice. Commitments range up to \$1,000 but sponsors will pay more if the painting they select is priced above their sponsorship.
- The **MAXIMUM SIZE** including frame is 1.22 metres (4 feet) on any side.

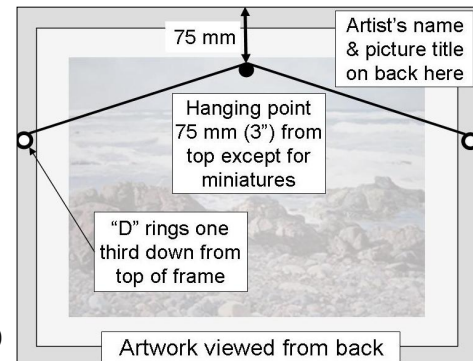

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ENTRIES. Entries will not be accepted without a completed and signed entry form. Photocopies of the original Entry Form are acceptable. For email copies see item 20.
- Entry fees. The entry fee is \$10 per entry. Cheques should be made payable to the Rotary Club of Ulverstone West Inc. See Entry form opposite for when and where to submit entries.
- All work must be suitably framed and wired for hanging with Artist's name and artwork title printed on back upper right hand side.—see diagram. Clip frames are not accepted.
- No copies, wet work, bark paintings, digital art, three dimensional art or photographs will be accepted.
- Each exhibitor may enter up to two (2) works. Each work may be entered into one (1) professionally judged category. Unless otherwise specified by the artist all paintings are eligible for the Central Coast Council Acquisition Award.
- All work must be the original unaided work of the artist, have been completed within the last year and have **NOT** been exhibited previously in the Cradle Coast Rotary Art Exhibition (*ArtEx*)
- Size Restriction. Entries greater than 1.22 metres (4 feet) on any side will NOT be hung
- The organisers reserve the right not to exhibit a painting but space permitting all entries will be hung.
- All works entered must be for sale and may be reproduced by newspapers, television or by the organisers for promotional purposes. Works must be priced reasonably to sell.
- COMMISSIONS - 25% will be charged on ALL paintings purchased by sponsors or the general public (except the Central Coast Award – where no commission applies). Please allow for commission when pricing your work.
- Irrespective of the artist's nominated selling price, the artist who wins the Central Coast Council Acquisition Award will receive only the \$2,500 Acquisition Award.
- JUDGING. The judges and the decisions they make are independent of the North West Art Circle, the Rotary Club of Ulverstone West Inc., Central Coast Council and the sponsors.
- At the Judges' discretion a painting may be awarded a prize in another category. Their decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- DELIVERY. All entered artworks must be delivered to the Ulverstone Civic Centre on Tuesday 8th November 2011 between the hours of 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm. Early delivery is not possible.
- Work may be freighted to and from the Exhibition. Return freight must be pre-paid or included in the entry fee. Works may be freighted for delivery to The Denture Centre, 52 Victoria Street, Ulverstone to arrive on or before Tuesday 8th November between 9:00 am and 5:00 PM. The Denture Clinic will only accept work delivered by a freight forwarder.
- COLLECTION. All artworks that remain unsold at the conclusion of the Exhibition must be collected on Sunday 20 November after 4:30 pm and before 7.00 pm. Artwork cannot be collected before 4:30 pm on Sunday 20 November
- There are no facilities for storage either before or after the stated time for delivery and collection. Uncollected work will become the property of the Rotary Club and may be sold for charity.
- The organisers will take every care with all work, but cannot be held responsible for any damage, loss or theft of any work in the Exhibition. Artists are advised to insure their work
- Exhibition Opening at 7:30 pm Friday 11 November. Entry is \$10 (Exhibiting artists are invited and pay only \$5). Public viewing from Sat 12 to Sun 20 November from 10:00 am to 4:30 pm; entry is \$3.
